We certainly want to reinforce if there are any concerns regarding safety or the safety of others the patient needs have an immediate psychological assessment at an acute care facility such as those listed above.

Each of these facilities have a 24 hours intake assessment area which does not mean your child will be admitted but does assure they will be assessed by a mental health provider at the time seen.

An additional resource for obtaining and immediate psychological assessment is the **mobile crisis unit** which is available in Orange, Seminole and Osceola County can be accessed by calling **211** or **407-839-4357(HELP)**. Brevard County has Brevard Cares Mobile Crisis Response Team @ 321-213-0315.

Mobile Crisis will provide a mental health assessment within 24 hours within the home setting with a goal of providing resources to avoid inpatient hospitalization if possible which is often much less stressful for the child and family
