Lake Nona High School PTSA is proud to announce its annual senior scholarships to students interested in pursuing a postsecondary education. At least TWO \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility:

1. Student must be PTSA member for the current year.
2. Student must be a graduating high school senior from Lane Nona High School in the current year.
3. Student must be a citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
4. Student must demonstrate academic achievement (minimum of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale)
5. Student must complete and turn in a scholarship application by March 26, 2021 by 2:30pm.
6. Student must provide verification of secondary education acceptance prior to receiving award payment.

Application Packet to Include:

1. **Application Cover Form**
2. **Academic resume** to include memberships in clubs/organizations, leadership roles, volunteer experiences, and work experience. Dates for all experiences should be listed. In addition, identify your most outstanding accomplishments.
3. **Letter of recommendation** from an adult (not a relative) that outlines why you should receive this scholarship.
4. Current unofficial **transcript** from your guidance counselor.
5. **Essay** on "Describe a challenge you faced during your high school years and how you adapted or overcame that in a positive way?"
Essay should not exceed one-page typed.
